**RIDE REQUIREMENTS:** Entries are open to all breeds of horses or mules 5 years of age and older as of ride date. Entries must be accompanied by your total entry fees and signed release. Last day to cancel and receive a refund is October 18, 2017. Refunds will have a \$20.00 office fee deducted and will not be mailed until after the ride dates. Clinic starts at 9am

**Camping the night before is at no charge but is primitive.**

**Check in Saturday and ride 25 miles on Sunday. 10 Miles for the Fun Riders.**

**JUNIOR RIDERS:** Riders under the age of 18 will compete in the Junior Division. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to ensure that Juniors 16 and under must be accompanied on the ride at all times by a parent or designated sponsor.

**RIDE RULES:** This is a SEDRA sanctioned ride **SEDRA RULES CAN BE FOUND ON THEIR WEB SITE: <http://www.distanceriding.org> - ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR A HELMET WHEN MOUNTED**

**EXTERNAL AIDS:** Only water and grooming aids may be used; no hoof dressings, ointments, salves or other medications may be used except as authorized the judges. No boots or other protective devices may be used on the horse's legs. No restriction on shoeing. Easyboots may be used.

**DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS:** No horse competing shall be given an illegal drug or medication for the purpose of altering the horse's performance. Illegal drugs are defined as, but not limited to, any stimulant, depressant, tranquilizer, local anesthetic, anti-inflammatory or analgesics (including Bute and Banamine) or any medication that alters the distribution of body fluids. The finding of a drug or it's by-product in the blood, urine or saliva of a horse will be used as evidence that such was illegally administered. There will be random drug testing using SEDRA rules. **WATER:** No hoses are allowed to be used on horses after you have vetted in. Mandatory holds will be away from camp. Riders may put out bucket, hay etc.

**WARNING RIBBONS:** A red ribbon must be worn in the tail of any known (or suspected) kicker. All stallions must wear a yellow ribbon. Ribbons should be securely fastened into the tail. It is the rider's responsibility to furnish their own ribbons.

**AWARDS:** Completion and six places in each weight division, number of divisions will be determined by the number of entries, plus Grand and Reserve Champions of the ride. Juniors have their own division and are not eligible for Grand or Reserve.

**CHECK IN AND VET IN:** Office will open at 8am for clinic and 2:00 PM on Saturday , October 21,2017. Vet in will begin at 4:00 PM. Vet in times are subject to change. The judges will examine your horse in hand and at the trot. Any faults, blemishes or unsoundness will be noted and evaluated for starting at that time. **Please plan to attend Riders Meeting.** Trails and times will be reviewed at Riders Meetings on Saturday night. Ride time for 25 miles is 3:55-4:40. On trail Vet checks will be away from camp.

**STABLING AND CAMPING:** Primitive camping only, no electric available. Generators off at 10 PM. Horses must stay on marked trails. Please clean up your hay and manure. Pens should not exceed 15'X15'. Space is limited. Please park rigs with others in mind.

**ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASHES. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**FOOD:** Lunch will be provided for clinic participants. Dinner will be provided for Riders and Volunteers on Saturday night. Guests may purchase a meal ticket for \$7.00 each night. Trail snacks will be provided on Sunday. Coffee and rolls/muffins in morning.

### DIRECTIONS:

From South : go north on **SR 441** to **SE 80th St** , take left on to it.  
go to **SE 25th Ave**( 1st paved road ) take left , then take right on to  
**SE 85th St** (a dirt road) Pass 4 driveways all on right( **4th is a dirt driveway**).  
Take right into pasture through gate **after** dirt driveway and Live Oak tree.

From North: go south on SR 441 to SE 80th St, take right on to it...rest is same as from south
