Location: Goethe State Forest, Tidewater Trailhead, Dunnellon, Florida, CR 337/336 **Directions: From the North**: I-75 South to exit # 382, Turn south (right) towards Williston, go 16.5 miles to stop sign and then turn left continue on 121/US 41. Go to stoplight and turn right, continue on 121. Go to stoplight- turn left, continue on 121. Go to next stop light - turn right and continue on 121 another 16 miles. Turn left on CR 337, go 6 miles- Tidewater trailhead entrance will be on your left.

From the South: I-75 North to exit # 341, Belleville/Dunnellon. Turn left on CR 484 toward Dunnellon. In Dunnellon, cross Hwy 41 at light and go to stop sign and turn right, continue on CR 40. Go another 4 miles and turn right on CR 336. Go 5.6 miles and turn right on 337, go ¼ mile and turn right into the Tidewater trailhead entrance.

Please try to have <u>No more than 2 horses in each electric corral.</u> Park tight, there are more camp sites down the road just past the main camp, the road loops back to Hwy 337 so you can go around the block to check it out.

<u>RIDE AND TIE</u> 6, 14 and 20 mile Saturday February 17, 2018

What is a Ride and Tie? A Ride and Tie is a race with teams consisting of two runners and one horse. The objective is to complete a cross-country course in the shortest amount of time. At the start of the race, one partner begins riding and the other running. After a distance, the rider will dismount, tie the horse at a self-determined place and continue on foot. Soon the other partner will reach the horse, mount and ride to catch his partner in front of him. By "leap-frogging" in this manner, the race course is covered by all three team members. The final team time is when all three team members have crossed the finish line.

Rules (not many-only one page) of the Ride and Tie are on the Website at www.rideandtie.org. Helmet use is encouraged for everyone while mounted. Competitors under 18 years of age must wear approved safety helmets while mounted during a race.

RIDE AND TIE Membership: All competitors must be members of the Ride and Tie Association. Membership costs \$25/person or \$40/family and is good for the calendar year which ends in December.
