68th 100 MILE COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE 1st THRU THE 4TH OF FEBRUARY 2018

The ride will be held at the Florida Horse Park located at: 11008 South Highway 475, Ocala FL. 34480. Their web address is: WWW.Fhorsepark.com, and they provide directions and a nice explanation of what is available at their facility. We will have the majority of it to ourselves, as they currently have only a dressage event scheduled for Sunday. Check in will be on the 1st starting at noon with Vetting starting around 3 PM. We will have a 25 Mile CTR on Sunday the 4th, but each day we will offer a 10 Mile Introductory Distance Ride (IDR). Please Review the Aerial View of the Horse Park and the FHA 100 Schedule. If you won a Challenge Trophy in a previous FHA 100, don't forget to have it arrive back at the ride site for this years' winner. The ride will use the Marjorie Harris Carr Cross Florida Greenway Trails, and we will be using the wider trails this year with all the holds in camp. We will use some single track, but the footing is good, and the horses will not need to be shod. No deep sand. The first two days we will have a "Fly By " at the Shangri-La Trailhead, and will have Hay and water for horses, snacks and water (the little bottles) for riders. Meals Provided: Peanut Butter and Jelly at the holds in camp, Thursday will be a covered dish with FHA providing Chicken. Friday is Pizza and a salad; Saturday will be from the Olive Garden (Mostly Lasagna, some baked Ziti) and a salad. Provided beverages for all meals will be soda, and water. Some of the Volunteer positions are covered, but we could always use more help.
