INTRO / 25 / 50 / 100

Come experience some Mississippi Hospitality at the 7th annual HUNTING FOR BIGFOOT RIDE being held amongst beautiful longleaf pines of the Desoto National Forest in South Mississippi.

CAMP - Ride camp is located in an area with flat easy parking and is primitive camping only. NO HUMAN WATER. There will be horse water available. Trees are available in some areas of camp for those who high tie. Porta potties will be available. No dumpsters available, so if you pack it in, please pack it out. Parking may be tight, so try and minimize your footprint. No generator cut off time due to 100 milers being out. However, be considerate of neighbors and coordinate among yourselves. All COVID related protocols will be in effect, i.e., social distancing, hand washstands, face coverings in close proximity of others, etc. This issue will be addressed at ride meetings which will occur at staggered times, per ride distances, in order to reduce the number of attendees. Meals available Friday & Saturday by vendor. Menu & cost to follow up. 100 miler hospitality tent with refreshments will be on site in addition to some refreshments at a designated location on trail. ALL vet checks will occur in camp GPS Coordinates to ride camp 30.6810 -89.0390. These coordinates are to the Big Foot trailhead camp area. Due to COVID, camp may be located approximately 1 mile to private property where it was for last year's 2020 ride. AERC signs will be up. Camp conditions still apply. If camp is to be here, while on horse at any time, please stay on the main gravel road that runs through the property and is marked with ribbons. Side roads and trails lead to owner's hunting areas that contain food plots, so please avoid these.

TRAILS - Beginner horse and rider friendly. Trails are permanent horse trails and are a combination of single and two tracked. Very little sand, only a couple of hundred feet or so. Gentle rolling hills with hardwood bottoms. There will be some dirt roads, with small gravel, riding on some trails, so shoes are recommended. There will be some lengths of gravel free/reduced shoulders. Due to safety, 100 milers' last two loops will be the same loop.. Plenty of water on trail with some being natural, pending rain. Helmets are required for Junior riders.

MENTOR PROGRAM - As with last year, for the 100 mile riders, we are offering a \$25.00 mentor discount for any Mentor / competitor that rides with and assists a Mentee throughout the ride. This would mean that you start with, ride with, and finish with a Mentee. Should either the Mentor or the Mentee be pulled or unable to complete the ride, the discount will still be applied. In the case of a Mentor being eliminated, ride management will make every effort to find an alternate Mentor to continue with the Mentee. Should a Mentor and a Mentee elect not to complete the ride together, then the Mentor will not be eligible for the mentor discount and will be required to pay the full entry fee.

ELIGIBILITY -To be eligible for the Mentor discount, a Mentor must have COMPLETED a minimum of ten (10) 100 mile one day rides. If you qualify as a Mentor and would be willing to mentor a "new to 100 mile distance rider" / Mentee, or have any questions please contact us so that we can assist you in pairing up with an appropriate Mentee. As a Mentor, if you already have a Mentee in mind, please list their name where indicated on your entry form.

Tee shirts for completions. Include your size on entry form & send in early to better assure availability or contact ride manager Jane Lee via text, e-mail or FB Messenger.

FROM THE EAST

I-10 West into Mississippi.

Exit 46B. Merge onto MS 15 North/MS 67, go approx 23 miles.

Merge onto US 49 North, go approx 3.5 miles.

There will be a BROWN road sign, McHenry WMA Shooting Facility.

Turn right on East McHenry road, go approx 4 miles. At stop sign,

turn right onto CITY road. At approx 2 miles, Airey Lake Recreation Area will be on the left, approx 6/10 mile past, turn left at Bigfoot Horse Trail signs.

FROM THE WEST

I-12 to I-10 in Slidell, Louisiana. Continue I-10 into Mississippi

Exit 34B US 49 North go approx 21 miles. McHenry WMA Shooting Facility

sign. Turn Right onto East McHenry Rd approx 4 miles. At stop sign, turn

right onto City Road. At approx 2 miles, Airey Lake Recreation Area

will be on the left, approx 6/10 mile past, turn left at Bigfoot Horse Trail signs.

FROM THE NORTH

From Birmingham take I-20 south to Meridian, MS.

From Meridian, take I-59 South to US 98E, exit 59. This is south of

Hattiesburg. Go approx 2 miles Exit at US Hwy 49 south, Mississippi

Gulfcoast/Gulfport. Go approx 40 miles on Hwy 49 S. McHenry WMA

Shooting Facility sign Turn Left onto East McHenry Rd. Go approx 4 miles.

At stop sign, turn right onto City Road. At approx 2 miles, Airey Lake

Recreation Area will be on the left, approx 6/10 mile past, turn left at Bigfoot

Horse Trail signs.

I understand that horses can be excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable, and that accidents can happen to anyone at anytime. I assume full responsibility for myself and the animal I am riding or in my care. I will hold AERC, SERA, SEDRA, it's officers and all individual members thereof, all ride personnel, and property owners over whose land I may cross, their representatives, successors and assigns blameless for any accident, injury or loss that may occur due to my participation in the Hunting for Bigfoot Endurance Ride. I further agree to hold any and all of the aforementioned individuals and organizations free from all liability for such injury or loss. This release extends to all claims of every kind and nature whatsoever, whether known or unknown, and I expressly waive any benefits that I may otherwise have under the provisions of the laws of Mississippi relating to the release of unknown claims. I understand that this release constitutes a limitation upon my legal rights.

UNDER MISSISSIPPI LAW, AN EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR OR EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES.

I hereby certify that my horse is not under the influence of medication and will not be treated with or given any medications prohibited by AERC rules. I also hereby give permission to AERC or it's duly appointed agent to take any appropriately action deemed necessary to check for possible administration of drugs to my horse.
