Horse water will be provided but if you can bring your own that will help immensely. Dogs are welcome but must be on leash at all times, no exceptions. No ground fires allowed. **CAMP WILL OPEN 10:00 AM ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 9<sup>TH</sup> AND CLOSE ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 12<sup>TH</sup> AT NOON.** 

TRAILS: Mixture of double and single track trails. Most of the trails have very good footing with some rocks, gravel and sand. For the 50's there is an approx. 1 mile hardpack lime rock road. Horse water and hay will be provided out on trails. SHOES AND/OR BOOTS RECOMMENDED.
50 Milers: 4 Loops (Yellow – 9.4, Orange – 10.01, Pink – 15.4, Blue – 15.3 = 50.11 Miles)
25 Milers: 2 Loops (Pink – 15.4, Orange – 10.01 = 25.41 Miles)
15 Milers: 1 Loop (Pink – 15.4)
10 Milers: 1 Loop (Orange – 10.01)
