TRAILS: **GREAT TRAILS** WITH THE COOPERATION OF MANY AREA LANDOWNERS, WE HAVE A GREAT TRAIL THAT CONSISTS MOSTLY OF FLAT, SANDY DIRT ROADS. WATER BUCKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE ALONG TRAIL. TERRAIN IS FLAT, SHOES ARE RECOMMENDED FOR THE LONGER DISTANCES – GRAVEL HAS BEEN ADDED IN SPOTS. PLEASE CONSIDER YOUR PARTICULAR HORSE'S HOOF PROTECTION NEEDS.

I understand that the sports of Distance Riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and man-made hazards, as well as wildlife and domestic animals, which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify, control or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control, and unpredictable; and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time.
