30-Mile horses must be 48 months old; 55, 65, 75 and 100 mile horses must be 60 months old. NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED AT CHECK-IN FOR ALL HORSES. ALL HORSES SHOULD BE PRESENTED FOR PRE-RIDE VETERINARY INSPECTION BY 6:00 P.M. Friday, November 25, 2022. PLEASE NOTIFY RIDE MANAGEMENT IF YOU EXPECT TO ARRIVE LATE. RIDE TO START AT APPROXIMATELY 7:00 A.M. Pre-Entry appreciated but not required, early entry discount of \$15 for payment in full and entry received by November 21, 2022. A full refund will be made post ride if you're unable to attend and notify the ride manager.

FACILITIES: "THE WINERY" (near Sugarloaf Mountain). Semi-primitive camping. Please keep dogs on a leash. Porta-potties are located in camp.

TRAILS: Great trails. The cooperation of many area landowners makes it possible for us to have a great trail that consists mostly of flat, sandy dirt roads. Water buckets will be available along trail. Terrain is flat. Shoes/hoof protection recommended for the longer distances – gravel has been added in spots. Please consider your particular horse's hoof protection needs. DO NOT PARK IN THE FIELD WE'VE USED FOR OVERFLOW IN THE PAST!!! Please be considerate and don't block parking areas for other riders! There is overflow parking available at the Winery, but there will be an additional charge to use the neighbor's property. If you wish to run your generator with no curfew, we can park you at the Winery. Contact the ride manager to make arrangements to park at the Winery, or if you wish to camp for more than 2 nights.

AWARDS: Completion awards available for pick-up at registration. Top Ten and First to Finish will also be handed out immediately post ride. Best Condition will be handed out when scoring is complete.

FOOD: Friday Night meal available - reservation must be RECEIVED by November 21, 2022 to guarantee food.

DIRECTIONS: **2643 Winery Road, Patrick, SC** . LOCATED AT US HWY #1 BETWEEN MCBEE AND PATRICK. FROM MCBEE IT IS APPROX. 7.5 MILES. If travelling North on US Hwy #1, LOOK FOR CAUTION LIGHT AT SIGN DESIGNATING RUBY RD. TURN LEFT, GO ABOUT 5 MILES, "THE WINERY" BUILDING IS ON THE LEFT, RIDECAMP IS ON THE RIGHT. LOOK FOR AERC SIGNS. **DO NOT PARK IN THE FIELD WE'VE USED FOR OVERFLOW IN THE PAST!!!**
