Location: Oakhill Farms 15864 SW County Hwy 484; Dunnellon, FL 34433 Lat. 29.0533 Long -82.3758 **Important:** Florida Law requires a current health certificate within 30 days with a current negative Coggins on all livestock traveling into and out of Florida. All trailers must stop at all agriculture inspection stations, even if you are not hauling livestock.

Directions: From I-75: Take Hwy 484 (Dunnellon/Belleview exit) and go west. You will go approximately 6 miles on 484 once you cross over SR 200. You'll know you are getting close when you see the Dunnellon Regional Airport on your right; you'll then see the Pruitt Trailhead entrance on your left; you'll go approximately another ½ mile to the entrance for our base camp, on the left.

Trails: Marjorie Harris-Carr Cross-Florida Greenways & the South West Florida Water Management District Trails. Terrain is mainly flat with good dirt/grass footing. If rain, there will be mud.

Camping: <u>Camping is primitive although we will have Bob with Levy County Animal Fund</u> <u>offering food for sale!</u> There will be a Port-a-Potty on site. Water is available in camp for <u>horses</u> <u>only</u>. All dogs must be on a leash at all times. **Remember, each horse owner, trainer and/or rider is responsible for safe camping and restraint of their horses/pets.** The entry fee includes camping on Friday and Saturday nights. Other nights are available at \$20 per trailer unless you have lots of horses and then the landowner charges more!

Cancellations: If you should have to cancel, withdraw, or pull before vetting in, the nonrefundable portion of your entry of \$50 for will apply for each ride. However, cancellation without 7-days notice, no-shows/no-calls and withdrawals or pulls after vetting the start line will not receive any refunds. Cancellations must be made <u>directly</u> to ride management via email.

Farrier and Vet Fees: Riders will be responsible for any individual farrier (on call) or vet services. Failure to pay any of these fees on site or make arrangements to pay in a timely manner will result in any rider and/or owner not being welcome at future rides, and potential forfeiture of points.

Everyone must wear a helmet when mounted.

Registration/Fees: Please complete the ride entry and sign ALL WAIVERS. All ride entries must be <u>received</u> by ride management WITH FULL PAYMENT on/or before 26 November. We will send a confirmation email for your entries! All others will pay a late fee of \$50 per entry. Returned check fee of \$50 – we can work payments with you as we understand cash flow!
